Maintenance

Cleaning regularly with a neutral detergent and buff tiles with a soft white pad, and mop regularly we recommend to add a capful of liquid wax to the water for extra protection. The use of properly sized walk-off mats at entrances and sweeping or dust mopping is most important to remove abrasive grit that may cause wear. Extremely heavy foot traffic or out-door installations may require additional maintenance. A natural patina will occur as the floor is maintained and wears.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. For daily maintenance or generic detergents mop regularly with clean water routinely.
2. Avoid use of abrasive materials such as scouring pads on glazed tiles as scratches may appear and glaze may wear off.
3. Clean and wipe away any spills on tiled surfaces to prevent scratching the glaze on tiles.
4. Gently sweep away sand or debris on tiled surfaced as it can scratch the glaze on tiles.
5. Avoid dragging heavy objects such as crates across floor which are laid with tiles not specified for heavy duty use.
6. Cleaning agents should not be used which contain hydrofluoric compounds as they are damaging to surface of ceramic tiles.
7. It is essential to follow manufacturers' instructions on the application of cleaning agents, to ensure that maximum results are obtained and damage to the tile surface is minimized.

Storage

Tiles are fragile product and must be stored in an area that it will be safe from getting hit by other objects. It's recommended to store vertically and raise them off of the ground and place other objects around them that will prevent them from falling over.
